The workshop he will be teaching, is on shewed quilt blocks. This is a method he uses for his Quilters DNA quilt. Participants will make skew blocks and assemble them into a wall hanging (or if your adventurous enough a quilt). Skewed Blocks Workshop Supply List:

Sewing Machine

Standard sewing notions

Graph paper, quarter inch grid Note: Staedlter's Bond, Quarter inch Grid is recommended in 11 x 17

or 17 X 22 but it is pricey. Roger will provide what is necessary for the first block and will sell additional sheets at cost. He says it is available at Staples but not at office Depot/Max

Freezer paper

Fine point Sharpie

Fine mechanical pencil (5mm or 7mm leads) Note: I have these if you need them

12 inch by any width plastic ruler

24 inch ruler with 30 degree and 60 degree lines on them

Fabric to make blocks, at least two contrasting fabrics, can be several coordinating fabrics and a contrast. Fat quarters are fine.

Irons and ironing surfaces. We need a few people to bring these to share.
