### Supply List for Charm Tote Bag

24 5" Charm Squares  
3/4 yd. lining fabric for bag  
fat quarter for flower  
1 5" Charm square for flower center  
3/4 yd. fusible interfacing for bag lining  
7/8 yd fusible batting for bag structure (you may use whatever type you like for your bag: fusible fleece, Soft 'N Stable)  
1 2" covered button set  
Thread to match  
Walking foot for sewing machine  
Usual Sewing Notions

Finished bag size:  
14"w X 12"h X4"d

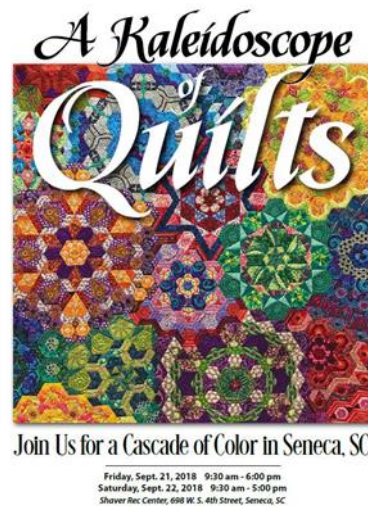
