## 2018 Quilt Show News

This is such a busy time for all of the members of the guild as we continue to prepare for the Kaleidoscope of Quilts, now only 2 short months away. I know sewing machines are humming and fingers are flying as quilts are prepared for this special guild event. But there are a few changes that you need to incorporate into your quilt NOW to make it ready to hang.

Last month the guild board of directors approved purchasing a new hanging system for our show. This will work nicely with our pipe and drape rentals and make the show so much easier to hang and bring a new level of professionalism to your beautiful work. With the new system **all quilts will need to have a sleeve on the back. Please prepare for a 3-inch sleeve for your quilt.**

Quilt entry forms with pictures will be taken on August 6 and that is the FINAL DAY you may enter your quilt. Remember that you may have as many as four entries with your 1st and 2nd choices guaranteed to be a part of the show. Please also be sure to prioritize your quilts.

We still have plenty of raffle tickets to sell. This is such an easy thing to do! People easily buy them when asked. If you sell yours and need more, please contact me at [denise.mccormick@blueridge.coop](mailto:denise.mccormick@blueridge.coop) and I can send you some. Also, if you need to turn money in to me, please email or call at 864-933-1392.

There are still some vacant spots on the committee sign-up forms. As you look these over, please make note of the times you will be available during the days of the show and determine which committee you

would like to volunteer with. As always we need food and fat quarters. Again, please come in August with lots of fat quarters for our raffle basket.

**Here's some food for thought:**

**We have 176 slots that must be filled in order to put on the show. At this time, only 51 slots are filled. We still have 125 slots to fill. Here's the breakdown:**

**Admissions - 10 slots of the total 20 slots still need to be filled**

**Book Sales - 22 slots of the total 26 slots still need to be filled**

**Charity Auction - 24 slots of the total 26 slots still need to be filled**

**Fat Quarter Basket Ticket Sales - 19 slots of the total 26 slots still need to be filled**

**Presentation Quilt Ticket Sales - 18 slots of the total 26 slots still need to be filled**

**Hanging Quilts - 12 slots of the total 18 slots still need to be filled**

**Preview Party Workers - 11 slots of the total 16 slots still need to be filled**

**Take Down Quilts - 9 slots of the total 18 slots still need to be filled**
